Applications are due by: October 16, 2009. Artists will be notified of acceptance by mail. All registrations will be accepted based on availability. All entries are on a first come first served basis.

HOW TO ENTER

Applications must be accompanied by registration fee. Include three representative photographs or slides of your work and one of your display. Please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of your photographs/slides and notification of acceptance.

SALES

Items for sale must be priced. Exhibits must be maintained from 10 am until 5 pm both days. You must supply your own change. Each artist is responsible for collecting Florida state sales taxes (7% in Pinellas County).

SETUP

To allow ample set-up time, gates open at 7:00 am on both days. (Keep in mind it may be dark while you are setting up, please have flashlights to help you.) Exhibits must be in place by 10:00 am. You may set up between 4:00 and 6:00 pm on Friday; however, although the park is safe, there is no special security on duty (see release form). Please, because of underground sprinklers, do not drive on the grass in this area. Your vehicle must be moved from the exhibit area by 9:30 am.

PARKING

You must move your vehicle to the overflow parking area (Gate #4) after completing assembly of exhibits. This is to ensure ample parking for your customers.

EXHIBIT SPACE

Spaces are located within the picnic area of the park. Due to the natural contours of the area, spaces vary in size but are approximately 10' x 10'. Tables or chairs will not be provided. Note: the exhibit area has many trees with low-hanging branches. If your display includes a canopy, be sure to indicate on the application so that you can be placed appropriately.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Every effort will be made to accommodate people with disabilities. Please include any information or concerns regarding the need for special assistance with your application.

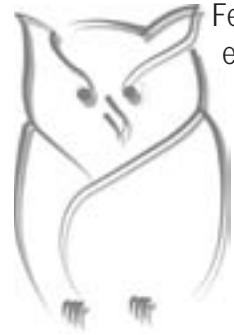

The Art Arbor Festival combines
visual art and crafts with music and environmental
exhibits, and offers opportunities for the public to
learn about this unique 250+ acre public nature
park located in south Pinellas County.

The exhibit area is situated in an area of lush
vegetation, shaded throughout by towering oaks
and pines, making this show a pleasure for
exhibitors. Live music, food concessions, children's
crafts and educational presentations combine to
make this a popular family destination each fall.



ART ARBOR FESTIVAL RULES

- ★ No post holes may be dug, and no objects
are to be used which will harm or deface park
property.
- ★ Work must be confined within assigned
space.
- ★ Vending spaces must be staffed at all times.
- ★ Artists and craftspersons **MUST** exhibit their
own work. Items not considered acceptable
are: objects cast from commercial molds or
assembled from kits, mass-produced items,
commercial displays, commercial art, crocheted
or knitted goods, velvet painting, manufactured
or kit jewelry, work which includes live plants
or animal parts, including seashells. Final
interpretation of these criteria will be made by
the Art Arbor committee.
- ★ Exhibits will be viewed by the Art Arbor
Committee prior to opening on Saturday
morning. The committee has sole discretion
regarding the removal of work which violates
Art Arbor Festival rules or was not accurately
represented by slides/photographs at the time
of application. Violators will be asked to remove
objectionable pieces or the entire exhibit. This
action will impact the exhibitor's participation in
the future activities in the park.
- ★ No pets (excluding service dogs) are allowed
in the park at any time.
- ★ The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages
is not permitted on City Park property.
- ★ Booths and booth fees may not be shared
unless all work exhibited is the product of both
parties.
- ★ Application represents a commitment by the
originating artist to exhibit and remain for the
entire event. Any exhibitor who does not fulfill
this commitment will not be invited to return.
- ★ In the event of inclement weather, no rain date
will be scheduled.
